Milo is a sofa collection with a quiet confidence about it. Low to the ground, clean in its lines and considered in every detail, it brings a sense of calm sophistication to any space it occupies.

Built around loose cushions and solid timber legs, Milo offers the kind of relaxed comfort that encourages people to settle in rather than perch. Whether specified as a single armchair or a sweeping corner configuration, it holds the room without demanding it.

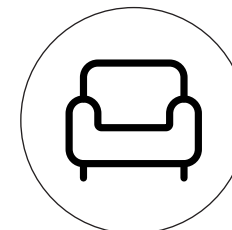

There is a particular quality to furniture that sits low and looks effortless. It does not try too hard. It simply belongs.

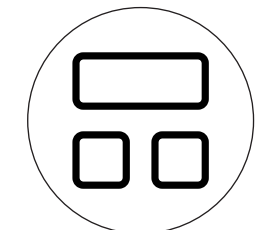
Milo was designed with exactly that intention. Its reduced seat height naturally encourages a more open, relaxed posture - easing pressure on the back and legs and inviting the kind of unhurried comfort that most contract seating never quite achieves. The **loose cushions** add to this feeling.

Rather than a fixed, upholstered surface, Milo offers something more personal - a seat that adjusts to the person using it, that can be plumped, rearranged and made one's own.

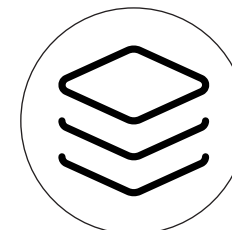
The **timber legs** ground the design with warmth and material honesty, preventing Milo from feeling purely corporate and giving it a character that works equally well in a boutique hotel lounge, a university social space or a high-end corporate reception.



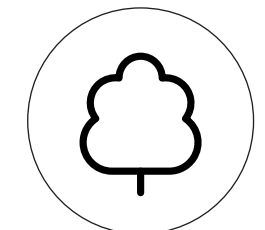
Low-profile seating designed to encourage a relaxed, open sitting position.

Good design knows when to step back.

Not every piece of furniture needs to make a statement. Some of the most considered objects are the ones that simply make a room feel right — that give people permission to relax without quite knowing why.

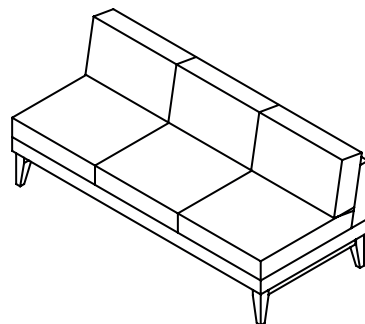
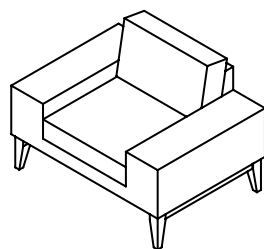
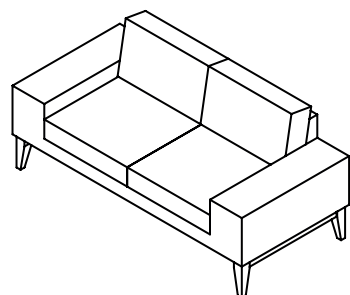
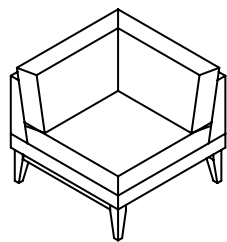
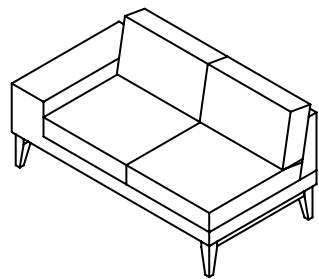
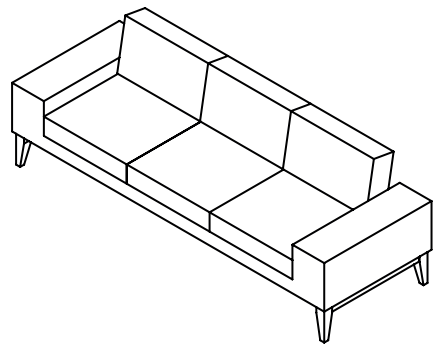
Milo is that kind of furniture. Its low profile and clean silhouette bring order to a space without imposing on it. Its loose cushions and warm timber legs signal comfort before anyone has even sat down.

There is nothing superfluous here. No decorative gestures, no unnecessary detail. Just a well-proportioned sofa collection that understands its purpose and fulfils it without drama.

From a single armchair beside a window to a full corner configuration filling a reception floor, Milo scales with the same consistency of character. Each module connects cleanly, each configuration reads as intentional, and the overall effect is one of effortless coherence.

Milo does not ask to be noticed.

It simply makes every space better for being in it.

Built around comfort

Milo starts lower than most.

The 780mm seat height is a deliberate choice - low enough to encourage a properly relaxed sitting position, high enough to remain practical and easy to get in and out of. It is the kind of considered proportion that only reveals itself once you sit down.

The loose back and seat cushions move with the person using them. They can be adjusted, stacked or flattened to suit different preferences and different moments in the day — a quality that fixed upholstery simply cannot replicate.

The timber legs carry the whole thing with quiet assurance. Tapered and well-proportioned, they give Milo a lightness that prevents it from feeling heavy in a space, while providing the structural stability that contract environments demand.

The overall effect is a sofa that feels more considered the longer you spend with it.



Why modular?

Modular

Milo is built around a family of eleven modules - from a single-seat corner unit to a three-seater sofa with arm - designed to give specifiers the freedom to respond to any space without sacrificing visual consistency.

The system includes left-hand and right-hand variants, open-ended modules and corner connectors, allowing configurations to grow from a modest two-piece arrangement to a large-scale installation that anchors an entire floor. Because each module shares the same seat height, cushion depth and leg detail, the result always reads as a single, coherent piece regardless of scale.

Timber legs are included as standard, bringing a material warmth that lifts Milo above the purely functional and gives it a character suited to environments where impression matters.

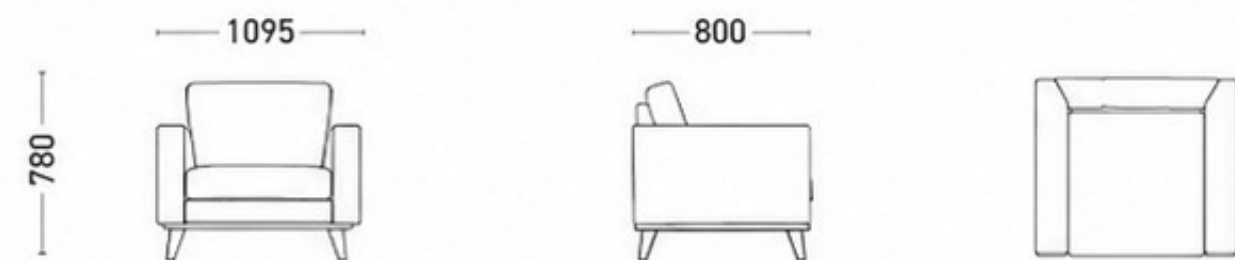
Loose seat cushions allow the level of comfort to be adjusted over time - replaced, refreshed or reupholstered - extending the practical life of the collection well beyond that of fixed-pad alternatives.

Upholstery is available across a wide range of fabrics from Camira and Panaz, with additional options available on request.

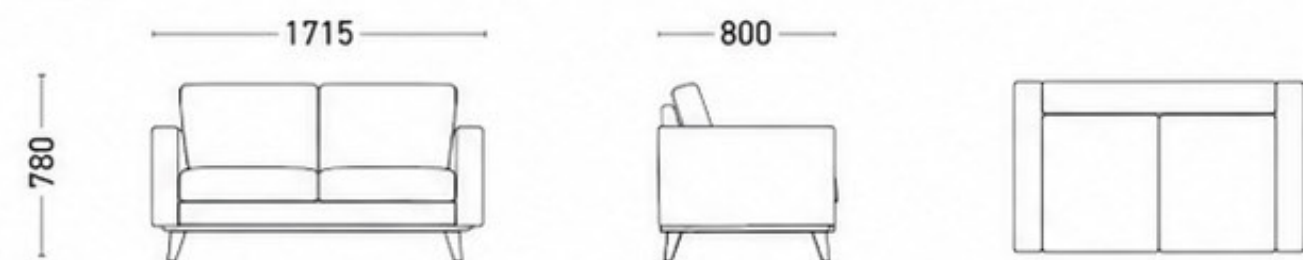

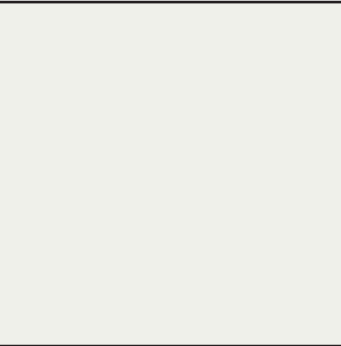
The collection also includes screen fabrics for vertical applications such as acoustic panels and privacy screens, ensuring both performance and visual consistency.

We utilize MFC boards along with layered, sound-absorbing structures and soft textile finishes to help reduce unwanted sound reflections from surrounding surfaces such as walls, furniture, and glazing.

The material composition is designed to support speech clarity and everyday comfort, minimizing background noise and improving the overall acoustic experience of the space.

You can choose from a wide range of finishes and material options to match your project's character and design direction. We use a selection of high-quality MFC boards from trusted suppliers, ensuring durability, consistency, and a refined appearance across all elements.

In addition to the standard finishes, custom materials and colors can be provided upon request. For larger or more specific projects, we are able to source and prepare tailored solutions based on the client's needs and preferred aesthetics.

Before you order

General

- By placing an order with 2020 Furniture Design, you agree to our standard Terms & Conditions, available on request or via our website.
- All prices are quoted in GBP and exclude VAT unless otherwise stated.

Delivery & Lead Times

- Pricing excludes delivery and installation unless specified within the quotation.
- Standard lead time for products within our RRP collection is approximately 4–6 weeks, subject to availability and seasonal demand.
- Bespoke products and customised finishes may require extended lead times depending on specification and project scope.
- During peak periods, including summer months, lead times may vary. Please contact your account manager for current production schedules.
- If shorter lead times are required, please speak with your account manager to discuss available options.

Delivery & Installations

- Installation services are available upon request and are quoted separately for each project.
- Where installation is carried out by 2020 Furniture Design, clear and unrestricted site access must be provided prior to the agreed installation date.
- Any preparatory works, including electrical works, site clearance or building works, remain the responsibility of the client. Delays or incomplete preparation may result in additional charges.
- Selected collections and bespoke projects must be delivered and installed exclusively by the 2020 Furniture Design installation team.

Warranty

- All products are covered by a 5-year warranty under normal fair wear and tear conditions.
- This warranty covers structural frames, foam and padding materials.
- Fabrics are covered under the respective manufacturer's warranty, typically 5 years depending on fabric selection.
- Electrical components, power modules and integrated charging solutions are covered by a 1-year warranty.
- Moving components and consumable parts, including hinges and door mechanisms, are covered by a 1-year warranty.
- Expected product lifecycle is approximately 15 years under normal commercial use conditions.

Care & Maintenance

To preserve the appearance and longevity of the product, regular maintenance and appropriate cleaning methods are recommended.

- Vacuum upholstery regularly to remove dust and dirt
- Clean spills immediately to prevent staining
- Avoid abrasive cleaners and harsh chemicals
- Use a soft damp cloth for laminate and hard surfaces
- Professional upholstery cleaning is recommended periodically
