Tall column planters anchor a corner or frame a booth. Every size available to order – and any size made to measure on request.

Choose castors for a layout that moves with the team, or glides for a fixed installation that stays exactly where it belongs.

Planters start from a straightforward observation: the spaces people enjoy most tend to have something living in them.

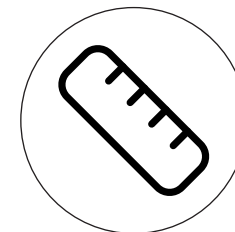
A planter positioned behind a sofa softens the acoustic environment without adding a wall.

A row of trough planters between seating zones creates a sense of separation that feels natural rather than imposed.

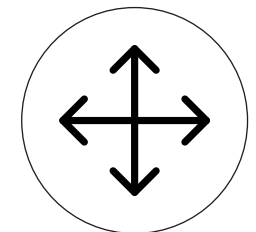

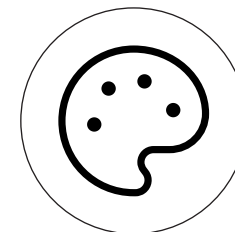

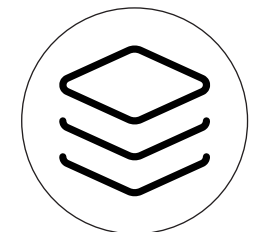

That distinction matters more than it sounds. People move towards spaces that feel cared for - and Planters are one of the simplest ways to signal that a space has been thought about, not just filled.

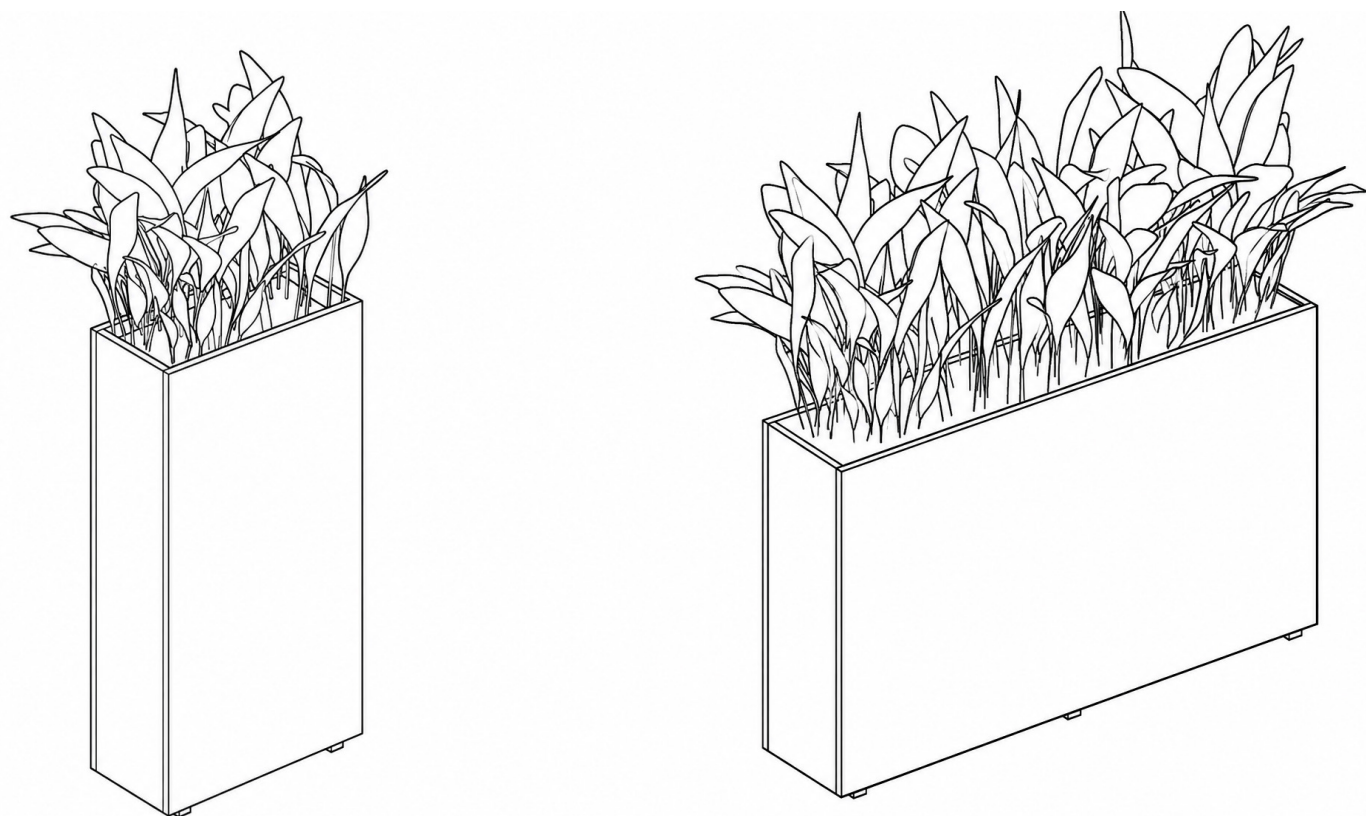
Planters was created as a complete seating collection rather than a single product. Every sofa, booth, bench and modular element has been designed to work together, giving designers the freedom to shape spaces without changing the visual language of a project.

Each planter is built from MFC panels with no metal frame - clean edges, quiet presence, and a finish that sits alongside the rest of the furniture without competing with it.

Trough formats create natural dividers between zones without blocking sightlines. Column formats provide height and definition in corners or entrances. And because every planter can be made to a custom size, the layout is never dictated by what's in the catalogue.

Available with castors or glides. Finished to match any project specification.

Planters work wherever a space needs a defined edge, a softer boundary, or simply something alive to look at.

Trough planters sit between booth seating and open zones, creating a sense of territory without a solid partition. Column planters frame entrances, mark transitions between spaces, or provide a backdrop to reception seating.

Available in the full MFC range, in standard sizes that align with our furniture collections - or in any custom dimension the project requires. Castors or glides. Low or tall. However the space needs it.

Why planters?

Because greenery does something no piece of furniture can.

It signals that a space is looked after. It softens sound without absorbing the room's character. It gives people something to orient towards - a corner that feels different from the rest of the floor, in the best possible way.

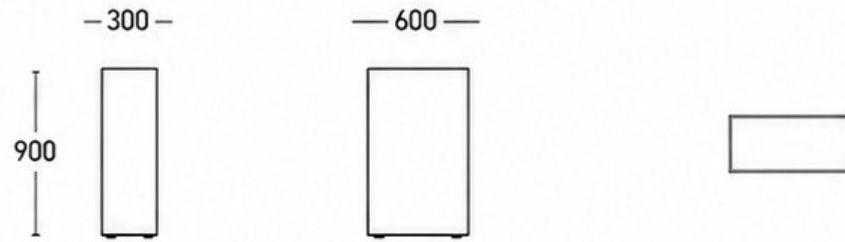
The finish is clean and the form is simple. MFC panels in any standard or bespoke size, sized to the project rather than the other way around.

Low enough to work as a divider. Tall enough to define a zone. Any size in between, made to order.

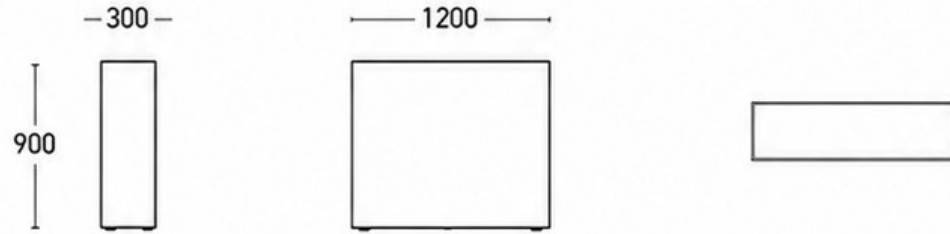

Spaces

The most used corners of a workspace aren't always the most designed ones.

They're the ones where someone put a plant, a comfortable seat, and enough separation from the rest of the floor to make the space feel like somewhere worth choosing.

Planters give designers a practical way to create those corners - clean MFC panels, available in low trough or tall column format, in any standard or bespoke size the project requires.

Position them behind seating to frame a zone. Line them between tables to separate without closing off. Use them at an entrance to signal a transition between spaces.

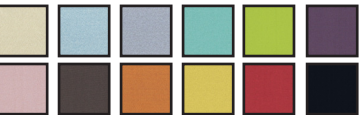

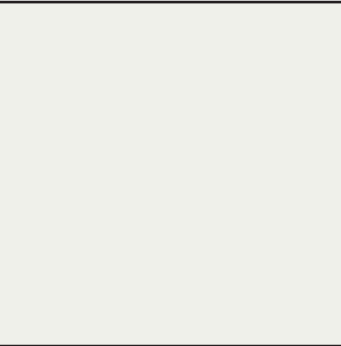
The collection also includes screen fabrics for vertical applications such as acoustic panels and privacy screens, ensuring both performance and visual consistency.

We utilize MFC boards along with layered, sound-absorbing structures and soft textile finishes to help reduce unwanted sound reflections from surrounding surfaces such as walls, furniture, and glazing.

The material composition is designed to support speech clarity and everyday comfort, minimizing background noise and improving the overall acoustic experience of the space.

You can choose from a wide range of finishes and material options to match your project's character and design direction. We use a selection of high-quality MFC boards from trusted suppliers, ensuring durability, consistency, and a refined appearance across all elements.

In addition to the standard finishes, custom materials and colors can be provided upon request. For larger or planterse specific projects, we are able to source and prepare tailored solutions based on the client's needs and preferred aesthetics.

Before you order

General

- By placing an order with 2020 Furniture Design, you agree to our standard Terms & Conditions, available on request or via our website.
- All prices are quoted in GBP and exclude VAT unless otherwise stated.

Delivery & Lead Times

- Pricing excludes delivery and installation unless specified within the quotation.
- Standard lead time for products within our RRP collection is approximately 4–6 weeks, subject to availability and seasonal demand.
- Bespoke products and customised finishes may require extended lead times depending on specification and project scope.
- During peak periods, including summer months, lead times may vary. Please contact your account manager for current production schedules.
- If shorter lead times are required, please speak with your account manager to discuss available options.

Delivery & Installations

- Installation services are available upon request and are quoted separately for each project.
- Where installation is carried out by 2020 Furniture Design, clear and unrestricted site access must be provided prior to the agreed installation date.
- Any preparatory works, including electrical works, site clearance or building works, remain the responsibility of the client. Delays or incomplete preparation may result in additional charges.
- Selected collections and bespoke projects must be delivered and installed exclusively by the 2020 Furniture Design installation team.

Warranty

- All products are covered by a 5-year warranty under normal fair wear and tear conditions.
- This warranty covers structural frames, foam and padding materials.
- Fabrics are covered under the respective manufacturer's warranty, typically 5 years depending on fabric selection.
- Electrical components, power modules and integrated charging solutions are covered by a 1-year warranty.
- Moving components and consumable parts, including hinges and door mechanisms, are covered by a 1-year warranty.
- Expected product lifecycle is approximately 15 years under normal commercial use conditions.

Care & Maintenance

To preserve the appearance and longevity of the product, regular maintenance and appropriate cleaning methods are recommended.

- Vacuum upholstery regularly to remove dust and dirt
- Clean spills immediately to prevent staining
- Avoid abrasive cleaners and harsh chemicals
- Use a soft damp cloth for laminate and hard surfaces
- Professional upholstery cleaning is recommended periodically
