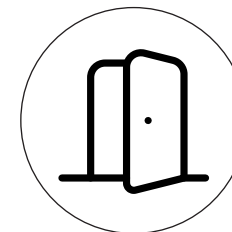
Crafted with care. Designed for people.

Every pod in the Solus range starts from the same idea: privacy shouldn't mean isolation. **Glazed doors** and walls keep people visually connected to the room around them, even while the upholstered interior absorbs sound and softens the edges of a busy floor.

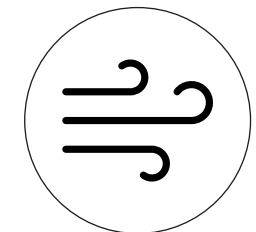
From a single open booth for a quick call to a fully enclosed four-seater office pod, Solus scales to the task - without ever needing a different design language.

Each pod is built around the same core elements: **a timber-framed structure, integrated lighting, air circulation, and a PIR sensor** - so the space is ready to work from the moment it's installed.

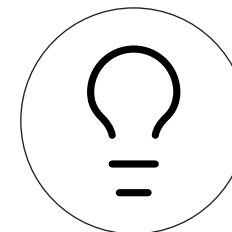
Whether placed individually or arranged as a row of connected pods, Solus brings a consistent architectural presence to any floor, without disrupting the layout around it.



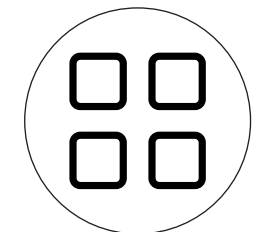
Glazed doors keep people visually connected, even in private.

Open-plan offices solved one problem and created another.

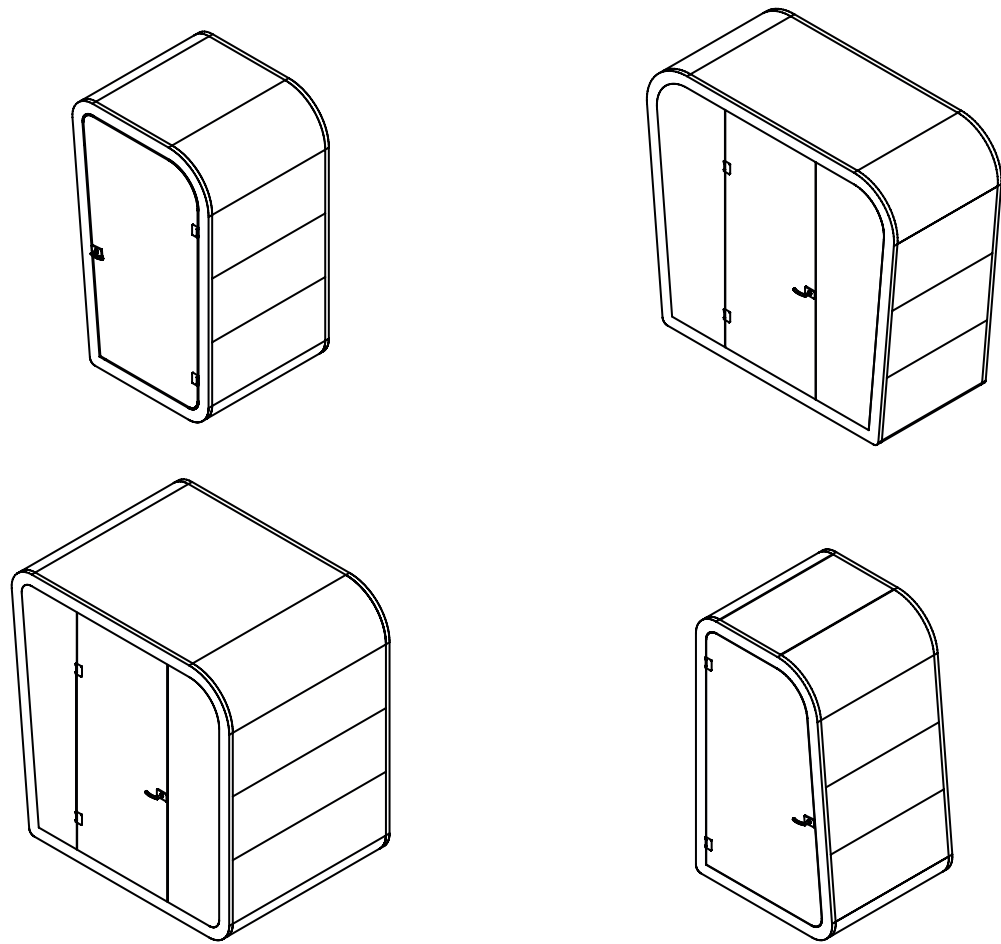
They gave people room to collaborate — and took away the room to think.

Solus was built to give that back. A pod is not a meeting room and not a desk. It's the place in between - somewhere to take a call without leaving the floor, finish a task without the noise, or simply close a door for twenty minutes.

Every pod is built the same way: a timber or MFC frame, upholstered or panelled interior, lighting and ventilation included as standard. What changes is the size — from a single open seat to a four-person enclosed office, each one shaped around how it will actually be used.

Solus doesn't ask people to leave the building to get five minutes of quiet.

It just asks for a corner of the floor.

Built for focus. Made to fit.

Open booths for quick calls. Seated pods for longer sessions. Fully enclosed office pods with a desk, storage, and glazed walls. Solus covers the full range of what a breakout floor actually needs - without asking for a different supplier for each one.

Standard finishes in black or white timber surround keep specification simple, while MFC panels, upholstered backs, TV brackets and power modules let each pod be built around the way it will be used.

A PIR sensor and built-in lighting come as standard on every unit - so the pod is ready to use the moment it's installed, not the moment someone remembers to wire it.



Why solus?

Most acoustic furniture is built to block sound. Solus is built to hold a moment.

It gives people a reason to step away from a desk without leaving the work behind — a place to take a call, write something down, or simply sit somewhere that isn't shared with twelve other conversations.

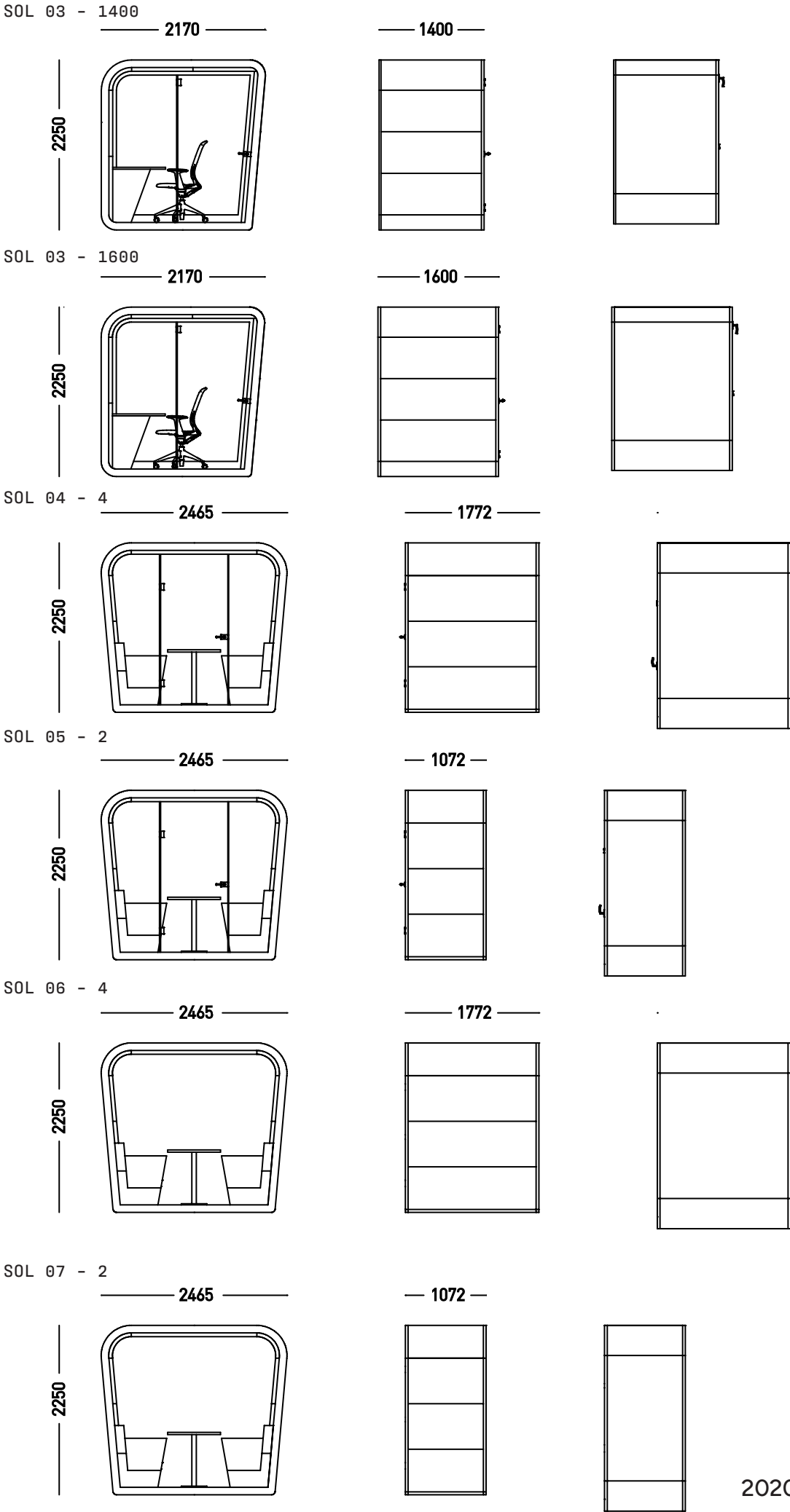
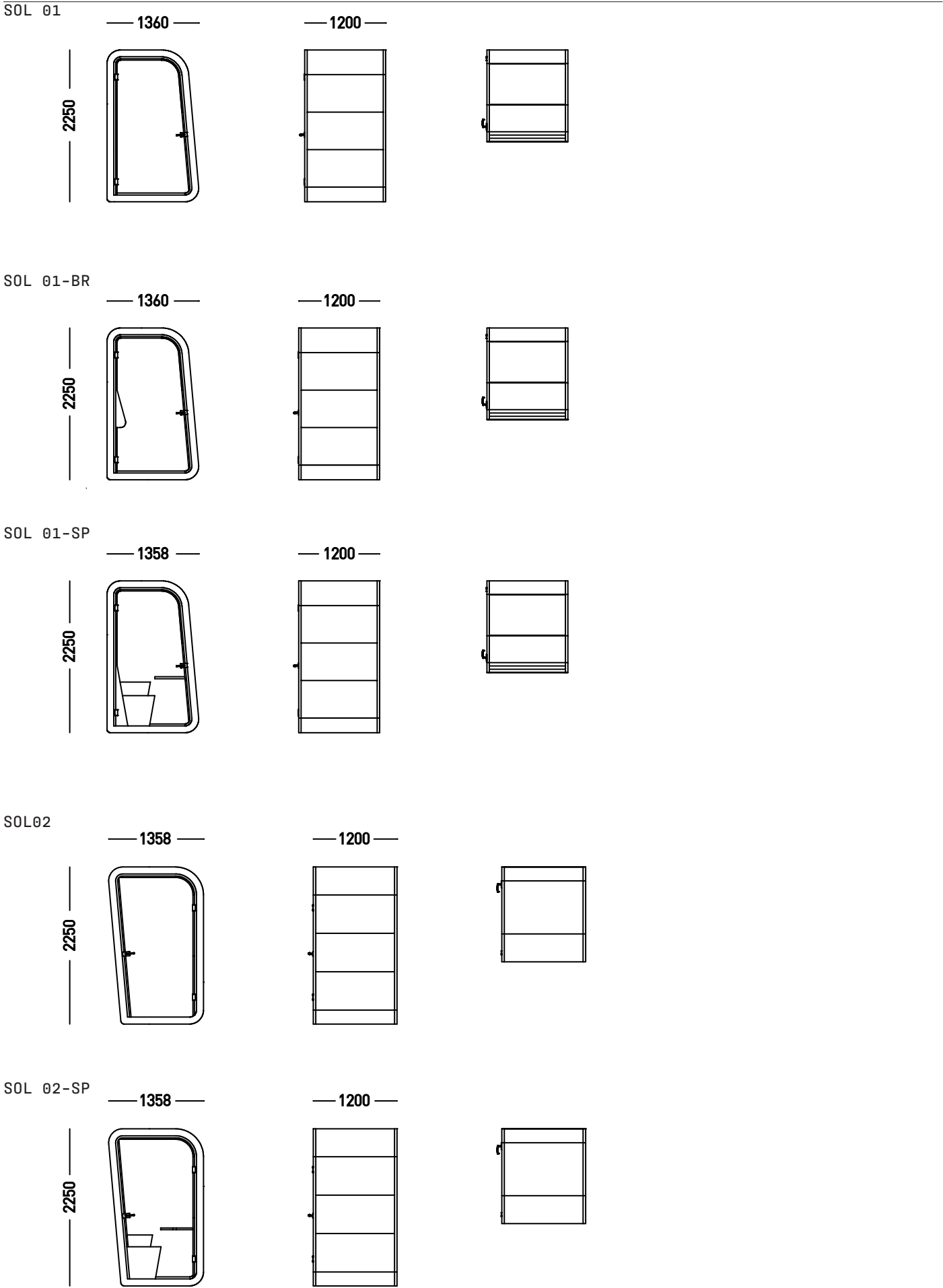
Every pod uses the same core build: framed structure, upholstered walls, integrated lighting, and air circulation that keeps the space comfortable even with the door closed.

Configured as a single seat or a four-person office, the system doesn't change — only the footprint does.

Solus creates these everyday destinations-spaces where conversations begin naturally, ideas are exchanged without formality and quiet moments are just as important as collaboration.

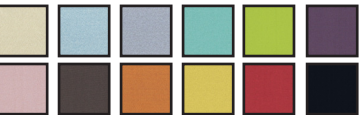

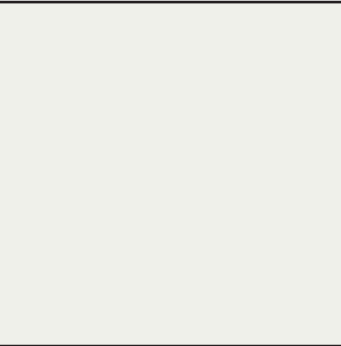
The collection also includes screen fabrics for vertical applications such as acoustic panels and privacy screens, ensuring both performance and visual consistency.

We utilize MFC boards along with layered, sound-absorbing structures and soft textile finishes to help reduce unwanted sound reflections from surrounding surfaces such as walls, furniture, and glazing.

The material composition is designed to support speech clarity and everyday comfort, minimizing background noise and improving the overall acoustic experience of the space.

You can choose from a wide range of finishes and material options to match your project's character and design direction. We use a selection of high-quality MFC boards from trusted suppliers, ensuring durability, consistency, and a refined appearance across all elements.

In addition to the standard finishes, custom materials and colors can be provided upon request. For larger or soluse specific projects, we are able to source and prepare tailored solutions based on the client's needs and preferred aesthetics.

Before you order

General

- By placing an order with 2020 Furniture Design, you agree to our standard Terms & Conditions, available on request or via our website.
- All prices are quoted in GBP and exclude VAT unless otherwise stated.

Delivery & Lead Times

- Pricing excludes delivery and installation unless specified within the quotation.
- Standard lead time for products within our RRP collection is approximately 4–6 weeks, subject to availability and seasonal demand.
- Bespoke products and customised finishes may require extended lead times depending on specification and project scope.
- During peak periods, including summer months, lead times may vary. Please contact your account manager for current production schedules.
- If shorter lead times are required, please speak with your account manager to discuss available options.

Delivery & Installations

- Installation services are available upon request and are quoted separately for each project.
- Where installation is carried out by 2020 Furniture Design, clear and unrestricted site access must be provided prior to the agreed installation date.
- Any preparatory works, including electrical works, site clearance or building works, remain the responsibility of the client. Delays or incomplete preparation may result in additional charges.
- Selected collections and bespoke projects must be delivered and installed exclusively by the 2020 Furniture Design installation team.

Warranty

- All products are covered by a 5-year warranty under normal fair wear and tear conditions.
- This warranty covers structural frames, foam and padding materials.
- Fabrics are covered under the respective manufacturer's warranty, typically 5 years depending on fabric selection.
- Electrical components, power modules and integrated charging solutions are covered by a 1-year warranty.
- Moving components and consumable parts, including hinges and door mechanisms, are covered by a 1-year warranty.
- Expected product lifecycle is approximately 15 years under normal commercial use conditions.

Care & Maintenance

To preserve the appearance and longevity of the product, regular maintenance and appropriate cleaning methods are recommended.

- Vacuum upholstery regularly to remove dust and dirt
- Clean spills immediately to prevent staining
- Avoid abrasive cleaners and harsh chemicals
- Use a soft damp cloth for laminate and hard surfaces
- Professional upholstery cleaning is recommended periodically
